Foreword

For over forty years, Priscilla Bacon Lodge has delivered specialist palliative and end-of-life care for Norfolk and Waveney. The care in the Lodge is provided by Norfolk Community Health and Care NHS Trust. Those who have had a loved one who has received this care or spent their final days in the Lodge, will know the benefit of this service and value the dedication of the staff and volunteers.

The Lodge was built in 1979, following a county-wide fundraising appeal led by Priscilla, Lady Bacon. Since then, the population of Norfolk has grown by over 220,000. This creates a level of demand that cannot be met in a building which has become inadequate and cannot be extended in its current location.

Despite the excellent work of Priscilla Bacon Lodge and other end-of-life services, the percentage of the population able to receive specialist end-of-life care in Norfolk and Waveney is amongst the lowest of any English county.

Priscilla Bacon Norfolk Hospice Care was created to raise £12.5 million to build a new specialist hospice which will replace the Lodge, and transform the provision of much-needed services across Norfolk and Waveney.

Priscilla Bacon Hospice will be built on an 8-acre site adjacent to the Norfolk & Norwich Hospital and will offer 24 inpatient beds. It will also offer improved day care and outpatients' facilities, as well as a coordination centre for the Community Nursing Team, who deliver end-of-life care in the community. The new hospice will also be a platform for education and research into palliative and end-of-life care, supporting improvements in provision locally and nationally.

The appeal was launched in February 2019, and a tremendous response from the people of Norfolk and Waveney, including the Priscilla Bacon Lodge Support Group, has resulted in over £7.1 million in cash and pledges, but there is a long way to go. Our network of retail shops

underpins the cost of fundraising and this means that 93p in every £1 given goes towards the capital appeal.

With continued support, we aim to start building the new hospice in the Summer of 2021, which should enable patients to be welcomed into Priscilla Bacon Hospice at the beginning of 2023.

Forty years ago, the people of Norfolk came together to raise the funds to build Priscilla Bacon Lodge. Now it is our turn to do the same for Priscilla Bacon Hospice.
