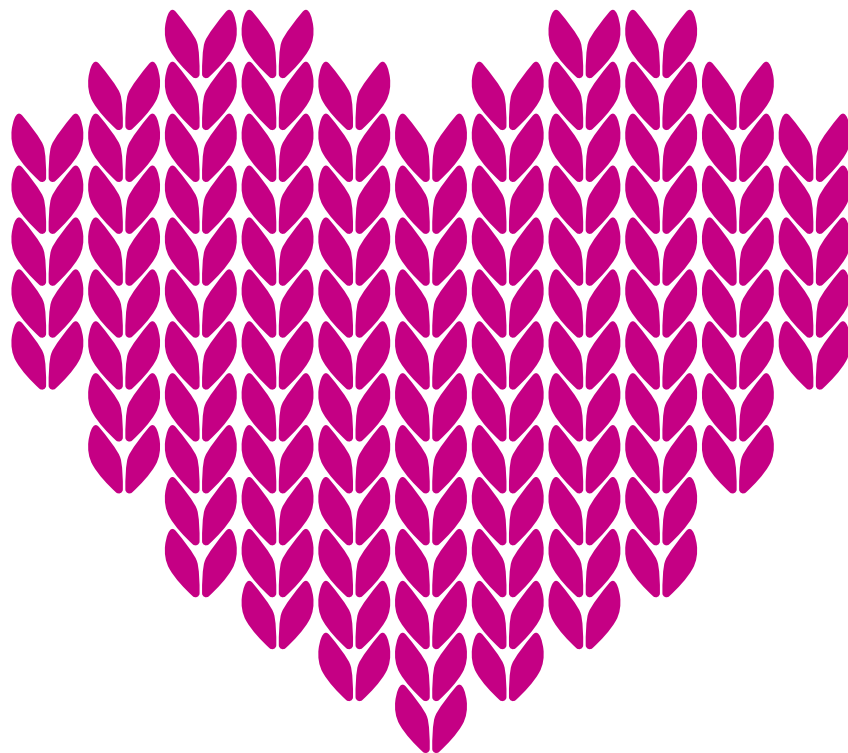


Comfort Blankets

Comfort Blankets

We are delighted to launch our 'Comfort Blankets' campaign in partnership with Norfolk Knitters and Stitchers!

We are inviting local knitters to create 6-inch squares, which will be sewn together into vibrant, handmade blankets for patients at Priscilla Bacon Lodge. These comforting creations will help enhance the homely atmosphere of the Lodge and bring warmth and joy to patients and their families.

Squares

Squares should be 6" (15cm) knitted diagonally corner to corner. Please use 4mm (size 8) needles and DK weight acrylic yarn in any of the following colours: fuchsia, baby pink, lime green, pale green, grey, and white.



Full Blankets

Blankets may be knitted or crocheted in any pattern or stitch, using any (or all!) of the colours above.

Please make the blanket 48" x 60" (122cm x 152cm).

Diagonal Square Pattern



Please leave a long tail when casting on and off for stitching up.

Starting at one corner, knit until the correct size is reached and then decrease to end.

- Cast on 3 sts.
- Row 1: Increase 1 st by knitting into the back and front of the first st and knit to the end (4 sts).
- Continue in this way increasing at the beginning of each row until the square measures 6" (15cm) along one edge.
- Next row: K1, K2tog, then knit to end of row.
- Continue decreasing at the beginning of each row until 3 sts remain. K3 tog and fasten off.

Drop-off locations

Squares and blankets can be dropped off, or posted to Priscilla Bacon Lodge:
